

ORDERS ON I.A.No.VII FILED BY THE DEFENDANT
UNDER ORDER VIII RULE I(A)(3) OF C.P.C

The present application has been filed by the defendant seeking permission to produce the additional documents in the above case by contending that during filing of the written statement the defendant could not able to produce certain relevant documents which are necessary to prove his case. The non production of the said documents are un intentional. Hence prays to allow the application by permitting the defendants to produce the said document.

2. On the other hand learned counsel for plaintiff objected the application by stating that the defendant has not stated any sufficient reason and there is a delay in filing the same. Further the said application is filed only to drag on the proceedings and prays to reject the application.

Heard both the parties on perusal of the materials placed on record, it appears that the reason stated by the defendant is bonafide and unintentional and in the interest of justice it is necessary to provide an opportunity for the defendant to produce the documents in order to prove his contention and if the plaintiff has any objection with respect to the above document he is having liberty to question the same during the cross examination of defendant. Hence this Court proceeds to pass the following;

ORDER

The application filed by the defendant under order 8 rule 1(a)(3) of C.P.C is hereby allowed.

The additional document produced by defendant is taken on record.
