

EXPARTE ORDERS ON I.A.NO.1

The plaintiff has filed the suit for permanent injunction to restrain the defendants, their men, agents, servants, supporters or anybody claiming through them from trespassing over the suit schedule property by removing fence in the western side, causing act of waste and damage, dispossessing the plaintiff from suit schedule property or in any way causing disturbance to the peaceful possession and enjoyment of suit schedule property by the plaiting. Along with the suit the plaintiff has filed application U/o.39 rule 1 & 2 of CPC seeking exparte Temporary Injunction restraining the defendants, their men, agents, servants, supporters or anybody

claiming through them from trespassing over the suit schedule property by removing fence in the western side, causing act of waste and damage, dispossessing the plaintiff from suit schedule property or in any way causing disturbance to the peaceful possession and enjoyment of suit schedule property by the plaintiff.
