



COMMON ORDER BELOW EXH.169, 170 & 171 IN
SPECIAL CIVIL SUIT No.24/2020

(Bhanudas Jadhav & Ors Vs. Prabhakar Bhagwat & Ors)

1. The application moved to condone the delay to bring legal heirs on record and setting aside abatement order. The defendant No.3 Anil Vasudev Bhagwat died on 13.01.2024. The delay caused to bring legal heirs on record as the plaintiff has not got documents in time. The defendants objected on the ground that the defendant No.3 died on 13.01.2024 this application moved on 27.01.2026. The delay is not sufficient be explained after material time the application is moved. Hence, it is necessary to reject the application.
2. Perused application and say. There is a delay of more than two years to bring legal heirs on record. To proceed in suit legal heirs of the deceased defendant No. 3 is necessary. Hence, application is allowed on costs of Rs. 1,000/- (One thousand only). Costs be paid to Legal Aid Authority. The plaintiffs are directed after depositing costs the amendment be carried out.
3. Issue suit summons to the legal heirs of the deceased defendant No. 3 as the defendants.
