

COMMON ORDERS ON I.A.NO.III AND IV

The present applications are filed at the stage of further plaintiff evidence. The plaintiff has filed the present applications under Order VII Rule 14(3) R/w Section 151 of CPC and Order XVIII rule 17 R/w Section 151 of CPC seeking recall of PW.1 for further chief examination and to produce additional documents.

2. It is the contentions of the plaintiff that recently he came across with material which are relevant and necessary in order to prove his contention and non production of these documents with seriously prejudice the case of the plaintiff and the applications are bonafide and there is no intention to drag on the proceeding and prays to allow the applications.

3. On the other hand, the learned counsel for defendant submits that the applications may allow on costs.

4. Heard both side and also perused the materials on record.

5. The present suit has been filed by the plaintiff against the defendant seeking for the relief of ejectment. By way of the present applications, the plaintiff is seeking permission to produce some

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revenue documents, on a contention that the same are very much necessary in proof of his case. On the other hand, the defendant submits no objection to the said applications. Even though the defendant has any objection he is liberty to question the same during the cross of PW1. Moreover in the interest of justice and to avoid the multiplicity of the proceedings it is necessary to allow the said applications. Hence the following;

ORDER

I.A. No.III and IV filed by the plaintiff, under Order VII Rule 14(3) R/w Section 151 of CPC and Order XVIII rule 17 R/w Section 151 of CPC, are hereby allowed.

Additional documents produced by the plaintiff is taken on record and the plaintiff is hereby permitted to recall the evidence of PW1 for further chief of PW1.
