

ORDER ON I.A.NO.I

The plaintiff has filed suit against the defendant for the relief of declaration that plaintiff is the absolute owner of the suit schedule property being perfected his title by way of adverse possession. Plaintiff has filed I.A.No.I Under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 of CPC praying to grant temporary injunction against the defendant, their men, agents, servants or anybody claiming through them committing waste , damage to the suit schedule property, attempting to disposes plaintiff from the suit schedule property or in any part of the suit property or trying to interfere with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of suit schedule property till the disposal of the suit.

I have perused the plaint and I.A. No.I and its accompanying affidavit sworn by the plaintiff and the documents filed along with the list. Since the property involved in the present suit is an agricultural property. Hence without hearing other side an exparte T.I. order cannot be granted. I do not found any ground to grant ad-interim order of exparte temporary injunction against the defendant. Hence, the following:
