

FIR No. 278 of 2025 **State Vs. Ajitesh & others**
Under Section :318 (4), 61 (2) BNS **REMP/204/2026**

1. Accused Nand Kishore produced before me being Illaqa Magistrate seeking judicial remand for 14 days as well as accused Mohit Goswami also produced before the Court seeking police remand for 6 days for recovery of case property and for arrest of co-accused from Ajmer, Kishangarh (Rajasthan) and Eta (UP) as well as for custodial interrogation in the present case.
2. Ld.defence counsel for both the accused have submitted that the charges against the accused are not made out and there is no ground to allow the application for police remand. Per contra, Ld.APP for the State has submitted that justifiable ground for police remand are made out to ensure the proper investigation in this case.
3. The police file perused. Arrest memo and other documents seen. The accused persons have been arrested in compliance of **Arnesh Kumar Vs. State of Bihar (2014) 8 SCC 273**. I am satisfied with the grounds of arrest stated in the application of I.O in writing has been intimated of the reasons/grounds of arrest and intimation about his arrest has been given to nominated person. No complaints against the police on interaction with the accused. Medical seen. No fresh external injuries reported. The arrest of accused is required for a proper investigation in this case.
4. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances, this court finds that police custody of the accused for recovery of case property and for arrest of co-accused in the case in hand is must. Resultantly police remand of the accused **Mohit Goswami** is hereby **allowed for four days**. I.O. is directed to make DD entry in concerned police station. In case, accused resiles from his disclosure statements, the I.O. is directed to produce the accused before Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate immediately. I.O., is directed to get done the Medico Legal examination of accused. Accused be again produced on **26.01.2026 till 10:00 AM**. Intimation of this order be sent to the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate Faridabad as per section 187 (8) BNSS. Last Zimni,

medical and disclosure statement seen and signed. Dasti copy to I.O.

5. Accused **Nand Kishore** be kept in judicial custody and be produced before the Court on **04.02.2026** through VC.
