

Heard Sri. H.S.R., Advocate for plaintiffs

The plaintiffs have filed suit against the defendant for the relief of declaration of their title on suit schedule property and for the relief of permanent injunction against defendant, restraining defendant his workmen, owners, servants, agent or any family members claiming through him not to disturbing the peaceful possession and enjoyment of plaint schedule property till the disposal of suit by way of temporary injunction.

Plaintiff has filed I.A. No.I under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 of CPC praying to grant ad-interim temporary injunction in favour of plaintiffs and against the defendants restraining the defendant his men, servant agents or any other persons claiming through him not to trespass, interfere and disturbing the peaceful possession and enjoyment of plaint schedule property.

I have perused the plaint and I.A. No.I and its accompanying affidavit sworn by the plaintiffs and the documents filed along with

the list. Since the property involved in the present suit is an agricultural property. Hence without hearing other side an exparte T.I. order cannot be granted. I do not found any ground to grant ad-interim order of exparte T.I. against the defendants. Hence, the following:
