CHIEF EXAMINATION BY LEARNED APP

I have been working as Doctor at Primary Health Centre at Balehonnur Since 2014.

That on 5.12.2024 at about 9.50 p.m CW1, 4 and 5 had come to the Primary Health Centre along with one H.C.285 of Balehonnur Police Station with a history of assault on them by Shabarish. At that time the CW1, 4 and 5 informed me that the alleged assault was committed by Accused with a beer bottle and his hands.

I treated the CW1, 4 and 5 at the Hospital. I noticed the following injuries on CW1.

1. Tenderness over left chest.
2. abrasion over left chest measuring 0.5x1CM brightish red in colour. The said injury No.1 and 2 are simple in nature.

I noticed the following injuries on CW4

1. Tenderness over right middle finger. Range of movement is normal.
2. Abrasion over right forearm measuring 0.5x1CM brightish red in colour. The said injury No.1 and 2 are simple in nature.

I noticed the following injuries on CW5

1. Multiple Abrasions over left elbow measuring 2 to 3CMx1 to 2 CM brightish red in colour.
2. Tenderness over left elbow and chest. Range of movement is normal. The said injury No.1 and 2 are simple in nature.

All the injuries were fresh and said to be happened within 24 hours. Before my presence the concerned police have recorded the statement of CW1. Further he has identified his signature on Ex.P1 and it is marked as Ex.P1(b). I have issued the wound certificates of CW1, 4 and 5 to the I.O.

Now the witness has identified the wound certificates of CW1, 4 and 5 along with his signatures the said wound certificates are marked as Ex.P4 to 6 and signature as Ex.P4(a) to Ex.P6(a) respectively. There is likelihood of causing of injuries as mentioned at Ex.P4 to 6 upon a person when the person is assaulted with M.O.1.

CROSS EXAMINATION BY COUNSEL FOR ACCUSED
SRI.HRV/KSS ADVOCATE

It is true to suggest that an out patient has to pay Rs.10/- fee at the reception counter at our hospital and it is entered in the register. Our hospital is 300 mtr faraway from the Balehonnur Police Station. Our hospital is 100 mtr away from Soundarya Hotel at Balehonnur. At Ex.P4 to 6 certain details are not filled up. It is true to suggest that I have not mentioned the assault details in Ex.P4 to 6. It is true to suggest that the injuries mentioned at Ex.P4 to 6 could happen even when a

person falls on the ground and while working in the coffee plantation. Accused had also taken treatment at our hospital on that day. I do not remember for what reasons the accused had come to hospital on that day. It is false to suggest that I am deposing false evidence before the court at the instance of police.
