Business : The claim petition filed by the petitioner under section 166 of M.V. Act, is hereby partly allowed with cost. The petitioner is entitled for compensation of Rs.5,26,813/- with interest at the rate of 8 percent p.a from the date of petition till its realization. The respondent No.2 is directed to deposit the entire compensation amount with interest within a period of 30 days from the date of this order to the petitioner account directly and submit a compliance report to this court. Out of the compensation 50 percent amount to be released in favour of petitioner and remaining 50 percent amount shall be kept in Fixed Deposit in the name of petitioner for a period of 3 years in any nationalized bank. The advocate fee is fixed at Rs.1000/-. Draw award accordingly.
