1. Whether the plaintiffs prove that Smt.Tulasamma died intestate on 19.03.1994, hence the plaintiffs being the legal heirs are entitled for share in the property of Tulasamma that is suit schedule property?
2. Whether plaintiffs prove that plaintiffs and defendant No.9 being the LRs of late Smt.Savitramma are jointly entitled for 1/3rd share in suit schedule property?
3. Whether plaintiffs further proved that they are also entitled for share in property granted to late Smt. Tulasamma in Sy.No.290 situated at Hariharapura?



4. Whether the plaintiffs prove that the Registered sale deed dated 27.07.2020, Doct. No.KPP-1-00444-2020-21 in CD No.KPP-D 419 executed by defendants No.1 to 8 in favour of defendant No.13 is not binding on plaintiffs and defendant No.9?
5. Whether plaintiffs prove that the sale deed dated 28.07.2020 Book No.1, Doct. No.KPP-1-00449-2020-21 in CD No.KPP 420, sale deed dated 28.07.2020 Book No.1 Doct. No.KPP-1-00448-2020-21 in CD No.KPP 420, and sale deed dated 27.07.2020 Book No.1 Doct. No.KPP-1-00445-2020-21 in CD No.KPP 419 executed by defendants No.1 to 8 in favour of defendants No.10 to defendants No.12 are not binding on the share of plaintiff and defendant No.9?
6. Whether the plaintiffs prove that plaintiffs and defendant No.9 jointly having 1/3rd share in suit schedule property?
7. Whether the plaintiffs entitled for the relief claimed?
8. What order or decree?
