This is the application for anticipatory bail of
accused/applicant **Naveen Chawla**.

It is submitted by both the parties that the matter
could not be settled in the mediation since the accused not
appeared in the mediation centre as per directions of Ld. Vacation
Judge.

At this stage, Ld. Defence counsel submits that a
demand draft bearing no. 000441 dated 25.06.2026 for
Rs.90,000/- in the name of complainant is on record since
furnished on 29.06.2026. She submits that at the instructions of
accused/applicant this demand draft be released to the
complainant. It is submitted that the compromise talks are still
going on and the remaining payment shall be made by the
accused to the complainant on the NDOH.

At this stage, IO submits that accused/applicant has
not joined the investigation.

At this stage, Ld. Defence counsel submits that the
accused shall join the investigation till NDOH.

In view of the submissions of both the parties,
following directions are being passed -

(1) In view of the no objection of Ld. Defence counsel, let the
demand draft available on record of Rs.90,000/- be released to

the complainant against acknowledgment;

(2) The accused shall join the investigation and cooperate in the same;

(3) Till NDOH, no coercive action shall be taken against the accused as per order dated 29.06.2026.

Put up on **28.07.2026**. IO is bound down for the NDOH.
