Q. No. 1 : Complainant has examined as PW-1, and PW-1 has deposed before the Court that you accused have borrowed hand loan from the complainant. What do you say?

Thereafter as per the postal endorsement, the said legal notice is returned to the complainant. Within a statutory period you failed to repay the cheque amount. What do you say?
