

ORDER

The petitioners have filed main petition U/sec.144 of B.N.S.S and filed application U/sec.144(2) of B.N.S. Act seeking grant of Interim monthly maintenance of Rs.10,000/- each.

2. Heard the counsel for learned petitioners. Perused the materials placed on record.

3. On careful perusal of petition as well as application, prima facie it reveals that the petitioner No.1 is wife and petitioner No.2 is son of the respondent. It is well settled legal principle that the father is bound to maintain his wife and children, irrespective of the fact that he works or he earns money or not. Maintaining his wife and daughters inescapable and inevitable duty casted on the father. The Court can take judicial notice of the intention behind provision of the Sec. 144 of B.N.S.S maintenance to the wife and children. This is foregoing to give safety and economical justice to estranged wives and children's. Keeping in view of the objects and statement of the enactment's and relationship between the parties, I am of the considered opinion that petitioners are entitled for interim maintenance.

4. After appearance of respondent to the proceedings has raised several contentions, Issues which requires evidence that can be decided on merits. Be that as it may. In view of prima facie position, petitioners are entitled for Interim maintenance.

5. It is also trite that the court can take Judicial notice of the inflation sky rocketing of prices as held by Supreme Court in AIR 1995 SC 498. Considering all these aspects of case and totality of the circumstance the petitioners are entitled for interim maintenance of Rs.2,500/- each per month from the date of this order. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:

::ORDER::

The Respondent is hereby directed to pay interim monthly maintenance of Rs.2,500/-each (Two Thousand and Five Hundred only) to the petitioners from the date of this order, pending disposal of the interim application.
