This suit is instituted by the plaintiff for the relief of partition and separate possession of plaintiff's 1/4th share in the suit schedule property and to handed over the possession of the suit schedule property and consequently, to declare that, the partition deed dated 01.09.2010 and 16.04.2013 in between the 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> defendant and partition dated 11.02.2011 in between the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> defendant are not binding of the plaintiff and for mesne profits with Court cost.

In addition to main relief I.A.No.1 is filed by the plaintiffs seeking ad-interim Temporary Injunction order against the defendants, their agents, servants or any other persons claiming through them, not to alienating, pledge to bank, or saloe to the any other persons pending disposal of the suit. At this stage the plaintiffs have made out

prima facie case. If exparte prohibitory order is not passed the purpose of the suit will be defeated. Hence, I proceed to pass the following :

**ORDER**

Issue Exparte Ad-interim order in favour of the plaintiffs against the defendants as prayed in I.A.No.1 till next date of hearing.

The plaintiffs are directed to comply the provisions of Order 39 R-3 of C.P.C.

Issue T.I. order, notice on I.A.No.1 and suit summons to the defendants.
