: Vide orders in Crl.M.P.No, this case is advanced to today i.e., on 20-07-2021 from 08-10-2021. A1 present. A2 called absent, no representation. Police filed report stating that A2 is not residing at his village Rotiguda and his whereabouts are not known and requested to split up the case against A2. From that it appears the presence of A2 cannot be secured in the near future. Hence the case against A2 is split up. The police concerned are directed to file certified copies of record in new CC. The section is directed to place the new CC before the court for appropriate orders. A1 filed application under section 265A Cr.P.C. and he is examined under in camera proceedings and he filed mutual satisfactory disposition. The matter is taken up and disposed of vide separate judgment. In the result, accused no.1 is found guilty, accordingly he is convicted U/Sec.265F of Cr.P.C. for the offence punishable U/Sec.269 of IPC and U/Sec.3 of Epidemic Diseases Act, accordingly he is sentenced to pay fine of Rs.1,000/- (Rupees one thousand only) for the offence punishable U/Sec.269 of IPC. In default of payment of fine, they shall undergo simple imprisonment for 15 days. Further, accused no.1 is sentenced to pay fine of Rs.500/- (Rupees five hundred only) for the offence punishable U/Sec.3 of Epidemic Diseases Act. In default of payment of fine, they shall undergo simple imprisonment for 7 days. Total fine amount is Rs.1,500/- (Rupees one thousand five hundred only). There is no case property.
