: Complainant LW1 Madipelli Raju and accused persons are present and filed an application Under sec.20 of LSA Act stating that they have compromised the case out of the court. At the request of the parties, the section is directed to refer the matter to Lok Adalat, the parties are directed to appear before the Lok Adalath. This matter is received by Lok Adalath Bench. Complainant LW1 Madipelli Raju and accused no.1 to 3 are present and they are duly identified by the police concerned. The offences alleged against the accused are punishable Under Section . 323,506 read with 34 of IPC. In view of the Judgment cited D.Raj Kumar V.State of A.P. and another in 2015 1 ALD CrI. 280 of Honble High Court of Judicature of Telangana and A.P. at Hyderabad that the offence Under sec. 323,506 read with 34 of IPC are compoundable in nature after obtaining the permission from the court. Accordingly, the offence Under sec s. 323,506 read with 34 of IPC is compounded and accused persons are acquitted. Vide orders in CrI. M.P. No. of 2026, the prosecution is permitted to withdraw the offence Under Sec.294 b IPC. As the charge is not framed, the accused is discharged for the offence Under Sec.294 b of IPC. There is no case property.
