

Sachin Versus State

This is an application for releasing the **vehicle i.e. Alto K10 Car bearing registration No. HR-30Z-9014 on superdari.**

Police/SHO report perused. Perusal of the police report shows that the vehicle i.e. **Alto K10 Car bearing registration No. HR-30Z-9014** in question has been taken into custody by the police and the police has no objection if the vehicle is released to its registered owner.

Submissions heard.

The applicant has submitted that he is the registered owner of the vehicle and has placed on record photocopy of RC (**Original RC is in police possession**).

It is further relevant to note that the trial of the case is likely to take some time and as such no useful purpose would be served by detaining the above vehicle in the police station as it may get damaged or may deteriorate.

In view of the above and taking into consideration the guidelines laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in case titled Sunderbhai Ambalal Desai Vs. State of Haryana, 2003 SCC (CRI 1943), the present application for superdari is hereby allowed.

Accordingly, the **vehicle i.e. Alto K10 Car bearing registration No. HR-30Z-9014** be released as per law on superdari in favour of the **Applicant Sachin son of Sh. Devi Singh** subject to furnishing of superdginama in the sum of Rs. 2,00,000/- with one surety in the like

amount **to the satisfaction of the SHO concerned.**

The **applicant is directed** not to change the nature and the ownership of the above vehicle till the disposal of the present case and to produce the same before the Court as and when directed.

The **SHO is directed** to retain the original RC of the vehicle and attach the same alongwith Final Police Report/Challan. He is further directed to prepare the requisite Inventory as per law with respect to the vehicle in question clearly reflecting its chassis number and engine number and retain its photographs duly attested by the Investigating Officer concerned and file the same with the Challan.

Copy of this order be sent to the concerned S.H.O. for information and strict compliance. Papers be tagged with the FIR/main file.
