What do you say?

Q-4: PW-1 has further deposed in his evidence before the Court that thereafter he has issued legal notice to you accused on 01.01.2018 and the said notice returned to

the complainant on 09.01.2018 with a postal shara “not claimed” and in spite of notice, you accused has failed to pay the cheque amount within the statutory period. What do you say?
