- 5) Whether the plaintiff proves that, the property purchased by defendant No.5 under the sale deed dated 13.08.2019 is not the part and parcel of suit 'A' schedule property?
- 6) Whether the plaintiff proves that, the sale deed dated 13.08.2019 executed by defendant No.1
