Today fresh power of attorney on behalf of plaintiff and defendant filed.

2. In pursuance of notice dated 23.03.2026, defendant appeared and suffered a statement to the effect that he is ready to get the sale deed executed in favour of the plaintiff.

3. At this stage, ld. Counsel for defendant submitted that since the defendant has no objection in getting the sale deed executed in favour of the plaintiff, therefore, the stay order dated 23.03.2026 may kindly be vacated.

4. On the other hand, ld. Counsel for the plaintiff stated at bar that he has no objection in vacating the stay order dated 23.03.2026, if the defendant is ready to execute the sale deed in his favour in accordance with agreement to sell dated 01.08.2023, upon which, ld. Counsel for defendant endorsed his no objection.

5. In view of submissions of ld. Counsels for the parties, the stay order dated 23.03.2026 stands vacated. Since the matter has been compromised, therefore file be put up in Lok Adalat to be held on 09.05.2026 for consideration.
