This suit is instituted by the plaintiffs for the relief of partition and separate possession of plaintiffs 1/3rd share in the suit schedule property and for delivery of possession of plaintiff's share in the suit schedule property by metes and bounds as per Sec.54 of CPC from the defendants and with Court cost.

In addition to main relief I.A.No.1 is filed by the plaintiffs seeking ad-interim exparte Temporary Injunction order against the defendants from alienating, creating any charge not to execute any sale agreement and mortgaging in favour of anybody in any manner in respect of application schedule property pending disposal of the suit. At this stage the plaintiffs have made out prima facie case. If exparte Temporary Injunction

is not granted the purpose of the suit will be defeated. Hence, proceed to pass the following :

**ORDER**

Issue Exparte Ad-interim Temporary Injunction order in favour of the plaintiff against the defendants as prayed in I.A.No.1 till next date of hearing.

The plaintiffs are directed to comply the provisions of Order 39 R-3 of C.P.C.

Issue T.I. order, notice on I.A.No.1 and suit summons to the defendants through R.P.A.D if P.F is paid.
