**ORDER ON I.A No.I**

I.A No.I has been filed under Order XXXIX Rules 1 & 2 R/w. Section 151 of CPC praying for an order of temporary injunction against the Opponents/ Defendants, restraining them, their labors, supporters, henchmen, agents etc., on their behalf from interfering or trespassing over the suit schedule property. Prayer is also made to grant an order of ad-interim ex-parte order of temporary injunction. No extraordinary ground are made out to pass an ad-interim order of temporary injunction, ex-parte. It does not appear the right of the Applicant/ Plaintiff would be defeated if notice is issued to the Opponents/ Defendants and they are

heard before passing any orders on I.A.No.I.
