**ORDERS ON APPLICATON U/OR.32 RULE 2 R/W SEC.151
OF CPC**

The applicants have filed this application U/Or.32 Rule 2 R/w Sec.151 of CPC to discharge the minor guardian from her guardianship and the 1st plaintiff also filed an application U/Sec.151 of CPC to discharge herself from guardianship of Dhr No.2 and 3.

2. It is averred in the affidavits annexed to the applications that, Dhr No.2 and 3 have attained majority and they are able prosecute their case independently. Hence, it is just and necessary to discharge the minor guardian by name Susheela from her guardianship. Hence, these applications.

3. Heard on applications.

4. Perused the applications in the backdrop of materials available on record. The plaintiffs have filed a instant suit for specific performance of contract in OS.No.292/2014. As on the date of filing the suit, plaintiff No.2 and 3/Dhr No.2 and 3 are minors and hence, plaintiff No.1 who is none other than mother of plaintiff No.2 and 3 was appointed as guardian for them. Now the present petition filed for the

enforcement of the decree passed in OS.No.292/2014 dated 04.03.2015. As per the school records pertaining to Dhr No.2 and 3 they attained majority. Hence, it is necessary to discharge their minor guardian and to permit them to prosecute the case in their individual capacity. Therefore, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

The application filed under Order 32 Rule 2 R/w Sec.151 of C.P.C is hereby allowed.

Consequently, the minor guardian of Dhr No.2 and 3 is hereby discharged and Dhr No.2 and 3 are hereby permitted to prosecute the case in their individual capacity.
