Case Called out. Accused No.1 to 5 present.

ORDER

Surety by name Smt.Vimala Bai W/o Venugopala, aged 56 years, R/o. Mudugodu village, Rangenahalli Hobli, Tarikere Taluk is present and files surety affidavit and produces RTC Extract of land bearing Sy.No.41/1 measuring 3.22 acres, situated at Halasuru village, Lakkavalli Hobli, Tarikere Taluk and also produced photo copy of her Aadhar Card and undertakes to stand as surety to Accused No.1 to 5. Perused and satisfied. Hence, same is accepted.
