

Bail Matter no. 134/2026
State Vs. Saurabh

This is an application U/s 483 BNSS, 2023 seeking grant of interim bail to the applicant/ accused for period of six weeks.

Arguments heard.

Ld. Counsel for the applicant/ accused submits that the wife of applicant/accused is suffering from lower back pain and requires treatment of medical ailments. He further submits that she has to undergo surgery and there is no one in the family of applicant/accused to take care of her during this treatment. He also submits that the applicant/accused has two minor children and there is no one in the family to accompany his wife to hospital. He further submits that earlier the surgery of wife of applicant/accused could not be conducted due to lack of money and the medical condition of wife of applicant/accused was not well for surgery. Therefore, he requests to admit applicant/accused on interim bail for a period of at least 7 to 10 days.

Submission heard. Record perused.

The applicant/accused has moved present application to release him on interim bail for a period of six weeks for the treatment of his wife.

Earlier, the applicant/accused was admitted to

interim bail for a period of three weeks vide order dt. 23.12.2025. During arguments of previous bail application, Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused had argued that the doctor concerned has referred the wife of applicant/accused to Ganga Ram Hospital where she has to be admitted for surgery on 24.12.2025. However, on perusal of present bail application, it is observed that the wife of applicant/accused had visited Shukla Clinic, Railway Road, Azadpur, New Delhi on 24.12.2025, 29.12.2025 and 31.12.2025 and it is only on 31.12.2025 the doctor had referred her to Ganga Ram Hospital, Delhi on 20.01.2026 for further health management. Thus, the wife of applicant/accused did not visit Ganga Ram Hospital even when she was already referred to that hospital. It is also observed that now the wife of applicant/accused has not taken any date of her surgery at Ganga Ram Hospital. Therefore, it cannot be said that as on which date the surgery of wife of applicant/accused will be conducted. Hence, the wife of applicant/accused can firstly take the date for surgery and thereafter the applicant/accused can move fresh application for interim bail. At present, due to aforesaid facts and circumstances, I do not find merits in the application, hence, the bail application of applicant/accused **Saurabh** is **dismissed**.

The application is disposed of accordingly.
