- 1) Whether the plaintiffs prove that, themselves and defendants No.1 to 6 are the members of Hindu undivided joint family and suit schedule properties are their ancestral properties?
- 2) Whether the plaintiffs prove that, they are entitle for 1/5th share each in the suit schedule properties?
- 3) Whether the plaintiffs prove that, the partition deed dated 27.05.2017 executed between defendants No.1 to 6 is not binding on the share of plaintiffs?
- 4) Whether the plaintiffs prove that, the registered deed dated 03.04.2018 executed by defendant No.3 in favour of defendant No.7 in respect of item No.3 of suit schedule property is not binding on the share of plaintiffs?
- 5) Whether the plaintiffs prove that, the registered deed dated 07.09.2020 executed by defendant No.2 in favour of defendant No.8 in respect of item No.4 is not binding on the share of plaintiffs?
- 6) Whether the plaintiffs prove that, the registered deed dated 22.08.2023 executed by defendant No.2 in favour of defendant No.9 in

respect of item No.2 is not binding on the share of plaintiffs?

- 7) Whether the defendants No.7 to 9 prove that they are the bonafide purchasers of item No.3, 4 and 2 of suit schedule properties respectively?
- 8) Whether the plaintiffs are entitle for reliefs as sought in the plaint?
- 9) What order or decree?
