ORDER ON I.A No.I

Plaintiffs have filed this suit praying for the relief of permanent prohibitory injunction against the Defendant, in respect of the suit schedule properties.

I.A No.I has been filed under Order XXXIX Rules 1 & 2 of CPC praying for an order of temporary injunction against the Opponent/ Defendant, restraining him, his workers, agents and representatives from interfering with the peaceful possession and enjoyment over the application schedule properties. Prayer is also made to grant an order of ad-interim ex-parte order of temporary injunction. The said application is accompanied with the affidavit sworn to by the Applicant No.6/ Plaintiff No.6 detailing reasons supporting his prayer.

No extraordinary ground are made out to pass an ad-interim order of temporary injunction, exparte. It does not appear the right of the Applicants/ Plaintiffs would be defeated if notice is issued to the Opponent/ Defendant and they are

heard before passing any orders on I.A.No.I.
