

Heard the counsel for the plaintiff on IA.No.I and II. Perused the materials available on record.

The plaintiff has filed I.A.No.I seeking permission to dispense with the issuance of notice to the defendant No.5 u/s. 264 of Karnataka Panchayath Raj Act. Perused I.A.No.I and satisfied with the reasons and hence, I.A.No.I is allowed.

I.A.No.II is filed by the plaintiff against the defendants No.1 to 5 under Order XXXIX Rules 1 and 2 of C.P.C. seeking exparte ad interim order of temporary injunction restraining the defendants No.1 to 5 or any body on their behalf from interfering with the plaintiff's peaceful possession and enjoyment of the suit schedule property in any manner, pending disposal of the suit in the interest of justice and equity.

The plaintiff has filed the suit for permanent injunction in respect of suit schedule property. Keeping in mind the nature of suit and on perusal of materials available on record, I deem it proper to hear the defendants No.1 to 5 before passing any orders on I.A.No.II. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:-
