

Execution (Comm) 178/2026

MS Sanrachna Multipurpose Constutancy Services Pvt. Ltd. Vs.
National Highways Authority of India

Present: Mr. Shubham Shekhar, Advocate for the DH.

1. Ld. Counsel for the DH submits that the present execution has been filed within the limitation of 12 year period, having been filed on 05.05.2026 which would fall within the limitation period keeping in view that the Arbitral Award was pronounced on 15.01.2014, and in terms of Section 36 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, the DH can take steps for seeking execution of the award only once the period mentioned in Section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act for filing objections against the Award, has expired.

2. Ld. Counsel further highlights that the JD / objector had 90 days to file its objections which is extendable by 30 days, on sufficient cause being shown to the Hon'ble Court, as per Section 34 (3) of the 'Act'. Ld. Counsel has submitted that the Objections were filed before the Hon'ble High Court on 12.05.2014. Consequently, as worked out from the said date, the present execution petition has been filed within the limitation period.

3. The argument raised by ld. Counsel for the DH is debatable. Consequently, subject to the issue of limitation being kept open, and removing of objections by the Nazir in its report, issue notice to the JD on filing of PF within 5 working days.

4. Put up for further proceedings on **21.09.2026**.
