District Judge / Senior Civil Judge concerned for the next date of hearing. Process be taken dasti if desired.

In terms of provisions contained in Clause 31 of the Modified Claim Tribunal Agreed Procedure, as amended vide order dated 07.12.2018 of the Hon'ble Delhi High Court in the case of Rajesh Tyagi & Ors. Vs. Jaibir Singh & Ors., FAO No. 842/2003, all the claimant(s) is/are directed to open MACT Claims SB Accounts in any of the nationalized banks near the place of his/her/their residence(s) and Manager of the concerned bank is directed not to issue any cheque book and/or debit card to the claimant(s) and if the same has/have already been issued, to cancel the same and to make an endorsement on the passbook of the claimant(s) that no cheque book and/or debit card shall be issued without the permission of the Court. However, the concerned bank shall permit the claimant (s) to withdraw money from his/her/their savings bank account (s) by means of a withdrawal form.

A copy of this order be also given dasti to the claimant(s) and he/she/they is/are directed to produce the passbook with necessary endorsement, as well as his/her/their Aadhar card and PAN card before this tribunal on the next date.
