

The Plaintiff has filed IA No.I under R/o 39 Rule 1 and 2 of Civil Procedure Code. The Plaintiff stated that the defendants are tried to interfere and dispossess them from the suit schedule property, hence the plaintiff has sought for restraining the defendants, their agents, P.A. Holders from interfering with the peaceful possession of the Plaintiff in the suit schedule property till disposal of the suit.

Perused the material placed before the court, at this stage this court is satisfied that the plaintiff has made-out a prima facie case and balance of convenience is in favour of the plaintiff. Hence following order.

### **ORDER**

Defendant, his agents, P.A Holders, Coolies, Friends, Relatives, Henchmen, Representatives any person or persons or anybody claiming through him are hereby restrained from interfering and dispossess Plaintiff from the possession of suit schedule property till filling objection.

Accordingly, the plaintiff is hereby directed to comply the Order 39 rule 3(a) of CPC. Issue

exparte T.I Order if provisions of order 39 Rule 3(a) of CPC are complied with.

The emergent notice on IA No.I to defendant if sufficient copies are furnished and PF is paid and returnable by 30.11.2024.
