



Order below Exh. 2A in Sessions Case No.

163/2025

(State Vs. Meghnath @ Meghya Hiralal Sonbhoir
& Ors.)

[CNR No. MHSN01002336-2025]

1] This is an application filed by one Rupali Mahadev Aparaj for interim custody of KTM Motorrad AG motorcycle bearing registration No. MH-02-EJ-5229, specifically described in para No.1 of the application, seized in Crime No. 105/2025 of Police station, Vishrambag registered under Sections 109, 3(5), 351(2), 352 of BNS.

2] Perused the application, Say (Exh. 6) of the Investigation Officer and learned APP. Heard both sides.

3] It is the contention of the applicant that, she is the owner of above-said vehicle. In support of her contention the applicant has produced verified copy of Registration particulars of the above-said vehicle. From the said document applicant seems to be the owner of the said vehicle. The Investigation Officer and learned APP vide their joint Say (Exh. 6) submitted that they have no objection to hand over the custody of vehicle on certain conditions.

4] Be it noted that, except the applicant, none has claimed the custody of the aforesaid vehicle. From the above document the applicant appears to be the lawful owner of the seized vehicle. No

purpose will be served keeping the vehicle at police station under the open sky for uncertain period. Keeping the vehicle lying at the police station would diminish the value and the performance of the vehicle. As such on certain conditions the vehicle can be handed over to the applicant. In the result the following order -

ORDER

1. The application is allowed.
 - (a) Applicant Rupali Mahadev Aparaj shall execute indemnity bond of Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rs. Two Lacs only) in favour of this Court by mentioning the description of seized vehicle, mentioned in para No.1 of the application and it be submitted in this Court.
 - (b) The applicant shall produce the said vehicle before this Court or any Superior Court, whenever directed by the Court.
 - (c) In the event of third person establishing his/her claim for the custody of said vehicle, the applicant will have to hand over the same to him/her.
 - (d) The applicant shall not create third party interest on the said vehicle or sell, alienate or hand over its possession to any other person till the conclusion of trial.
2. The Police Officer of Police Station, Vishrambag shall hand over the custody of seized vehicle to

the applicant under the panchanama to be drawn in presence of two panch witnesses and its photographs shall be taken from all angles and cost of the same shall be borne by the applicant.

3. Issue letter to the concerned Police Station accordingly.
