

The plaintiffs have filed application U/o 5 Rule 20 of CPC and pray this court that issue summons to Defendant No.3 through substitute service by way of paper publication in daily news paper. It is stated that the Plaintiffs have taken steps against Defendant No.3 on several times through court as well as RPAD and also through by way of paper publication, but the Defendant No.3 intentionally evaded to take summons of this court. Accordingly, they pray this court that issue the summons to Defendant No.3 through substitute service i.e by way of paper publication.
