

This suit is filed by the plaintiffs against the defendants for the relief of partition and separate possession.

Now, the plaintiffs are seeking an order of temporary injunction against the defendant No. 5 and his men, agents, servants or anybody those who are claiming under him from alienating the item No. 1 of the suit schedule properties to third parties.

Heard the learned counsel for the plaintiffs.

In support of the plaintiffs case, they have produced genealogy tree, copies of Adangal, RSR vahi, RTC, EC, MR, registered sale deeds etc.,

On perusal of the materials available on record and the documents produced by the plaintiffs at this stage, the plaintiffs have made out a prima-facie case to grant interim order of temporary injunction. Hence, issuance of notice is dispensed with. Accordingly, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER:

I.A. No. III filed by the applicants/plaintiffs U/o. 39 Rule 1 and

2 of CPC for seeking an interim order of temporary injunction is allowed.

The defendant No. 5 and his men, agents, servants or anybody those who are claiming under him from alienating the item No. 1 of the suit schedule properties to third parties till appearance of the defendant.

The plaintiffs shall comply the provision of Order 39 Rule 3 of CPC.

Issue temporary injunction order against the defendants and notice on I.A. No. III and suit summons to the defendants returnable by 02.05.2026.
