Complaint under section 138 Negotiable & Instruments Act has been moved before me. It be checked and registered.

In preliminary evidence, the complainant has tendered his affidavit Ex.CW-1/A alongwith documents Ex.C1 to Ex. C9 to and closed preliminary evidence. Heard on the point of summoning of accused. There is prima facie sufficient material to issue process against the accused u/s 138 Negotiable Instruments Act. The undersigned had also conducted inquiry under Section 202 Cr.P.C. The detailed expression of opinion is avoided as it is no longer necessary in view of the observation of **Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in U.P. Pollution Board Versus Mohan Meekan, 2000(2) RCR 421** and reiterated in **Deputy Chief Controller of import and export Versus Roshan Lal Aggarwal, 2003(2) RCR (CrI)110(SC)**.

Now, accused be summoned through RC/ speed post for 31.1.2023 on filing of PF,RC and copy of complaint within a week.

The complainant is at liberty to effect service through **e-mail, whatsapp** too as per law. The complainant is at liberty to take **dasti** notice at own responsibility to ensure the service upon the accused for the date fixed. If accused is not found at the stated address, **notice served by way of affixation**.
