1. *Whether the plaintiff proves that suit schedule properties are the ancestral and joint family properties of himself and defendant No. 1 to 8?*
2. *Whether the plaintiff further proves that one Venkataramana Naidu who is the son of brother of deceased Krishnappa Naidu entered into the registered partition deed with the 1st defendant on 10.07.2019 and divided the properties?*
3. *Whether the plaintiff further proves that the defendant No. 1 to 4 have sold the A schedule property to 9th defendant on 09.09.2020, which is not binding on him?*
4. *Whether the plaintiff further proves that the 1st defendant also executed the registered gift deed on 09.09.2020 to the 4th defendant in respect of portion of 2 acres in item No. 'H' schedule property, which is not binding on him?*
5. *Whether the plaintiff proves the alleged interference by the defendants?*
6. *Whether the plaintiff is entitled for the relief of permanent injunction?*
7. *Whether the plaintiff is entitled for partition and separate possession of his 1/6th share in the suit schedule properties?*
8. *What order or decree?*
