ISSUES

- 1) Whether the plaintiff proves that, she is the Class-I legal heir of deceased son by name N.Ravi?
- 2) Whether the plaintiff proves that her son N.Ravi was acquired the suit schedule item No.1 to 5 properties by way of partition and sale deeds dated 08.04.2015, 26.10.2017, 27.08.2018, 19.02.2020 respectively?
- 3) Whether the plaintiff proves that, the 8th defendant owns the suit schedule item No.1, 3 and 5 and is in possession during the lifetime of deceased N.Ravi as coolie worker?
- 4) Whether the plaintiff proves that, the defendant No.8 and 9 have not rights and interest over the suit schedule properties and they have falsificated some unenforceable documents?
- 5) Whether the plaintiff proves that she is the owner in possession and enjoyment of the suit schedule properties as a successor?
- 6) Whether the plaintiff proves that, the documents issued by the defendant No.7 in favour of defendant No.8 and 9 are void and never created right of successor in favour of defendant No.8 and 9?
- 7) Whether the plaintiff is entitled for the relief of possession over the suit schedule item No.1, 3, 5 properties from the defendant No.8 and 9?
- 8) Whether the defendant No.8 and 9 prove that the defendant No.8 is the wife of the plaintiff's son N.Ravi and defendant No.9 is the son of said Ravi?

- 9) Whether the defendant proves that 8th defendant has obtained the loan from the Mahila Sangha at the time of purchasing suit schedule item No.2 to 5 by the Ravi and he was signed the said documents?
- 10) Whether the plaintiff is entitled for the relief as sought for?
- 11) What Order or decree?
