

ORDERS ON I.A

The learned counsel for the plaintiffs have filed the application U/o 32 rule 12(2) of CPC and prays the court to discharge the guardian on the ground that the plaintiffs No. 2 attained the majority.

2. The copy of the application is served on the other side who in turn submits that he has no objections to allow the application.

3. Heard the arguments.

On perusal of the documents placed before the court goes to show that the plaintiffs No. 2 was born on 20.03.1997, so he attained majority and he can proceed with the matter without the assistance of the guardian. Hence there is no necessity of guardianship to conduct the case on behalf of 2nd plaintiff. Accordingly, I proceed to pass the following -

ORDER

I.A No. 14 filed by the plaintiff No. 2 is hereby allowed.

The 1st plaintiff is discharged from guardianship of plaintiff No. 2.

The plaintiff counsel is directed to carryout amendment in the cause title.
