The reason for return of the cheques in question as per return memo is “Account Blocked, situation covered in 21-25”. There is ambiguity as to whether the dishonour of cheque for afore-said reason amounts to an offence under/s 138 NI Act.

Thus, to clear the said ambiguity, let notice be issued to the **banker of accused so as to explain the reason for dishonour of cheque**, on filing of PF within 30 days from today, returnable for **10.07.2026**.

Complainant is directed to furnish complete particulars of the bank witness along-with PF form. The aforesaid notice shall be accompanied by copy of cheque in question as well as cheque return memo.

The bank witness is directed to appear on NDOH along-with her authority letter.
