

Shriram City Union Finance Limited VS Prem

An application for bail has been filed. Accused appeared upon bailable warrants. Power of attorney filed on behalf of accused.

Heard. Offence being bailable and considering the allegations, punishment prescribed and the fact that the trial of the case is likely to take long time, no useful purpose would be served by detaining the accused behind the bar, accused is admitted to bail on furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.30,000/- with one surety in the like amount. Bail bonds furnished, accepted and attested. Accused **Prem** is hereby released on bail in this case, if accused is not required in any other case. **Intimation regarding the details of land of the surety be sent to the Tehsildar/ Registering Authority for making necessary endorsement in the record regarding furnishing of surety bond by the surety in the court, in view of the order dated 1.6.2018 passed by the Hon'ble High Court in Civil Writ Petition No. 4898 of 2018 received from the office of the Id. Distt. & Sessions Judge, Karnal bearing endorsement no. 10147 dated 5.7.2018.**

Heard on notice of accusation. Case file perused. Upon finding a prima facie case, notice of accusation for having committed a prima-facie offence u/s 138 of Negotiable Instrument Act served upon the accused in terms of section 251 Cr.P.C. to which the accused pleaded not guilty and claimed trial.

Now to come up on **19.4.2024** for recording the statement of accused under Section 263(g) Cr.P.C.
