I S S U E S

1. Whether the plaintiff proves that it has agreed to sell yarn to the 1st defendant company on credit basis, several transactions took place between both the parties, and the defendants are in due for a total sum of ₹1,85,74,878.90 with current and future interest at the rate of 12% per annum on ₹1,39,98,716/- from the date of suit till realization?
2. Whether the defendants prove that suit is not maintainable on the point of jurisdiction?
3. Whether the defendants prove that the suit is bad for non-joinder and mis-joinder of necessary parties?
4. Whether the defendants prove that the suit is barred by principles of estoppels and waiver?
5. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for the suit claim?
