ORDER

1. The petitioner/accused No.2 has filed this petition U/s.482 of BNS 2023 seeking for an order of anticipatory bail.
2. On the basis of the complaint filed by Smt.Lalitamma PSI, a case is registered at Gandhinagara police station in Crime No.34/2026 against the accused for the offences punishable U/S.121(1), 132, 352 R/W.3(5) of BNS 2023.
3. The case of the prosecution in brief is that, on 01/03/2026 at about 7-00 p.m. when the complainant was doing her official duty near Shri Durgambika temple of Davanagere along with her staff there was a rush near bangle shop. Hence the complainant being PSI went to that place along with her staff and doing her duty. During that time this accused No.1 and 2 picked up quarrel with the complainant and assaulted the complainant on her cheek and insulted her in front of the public and abused her in a filthy language and thereby committed the offences. Now investigation is going on.

4. Now this petitioner/accused No.2 is contending that, she is an innocent person and she has not committed any offence. False case is registered against her. The complainant police with an ill will and malafide intention have filed false FIR on the basis of a concocted story. This petitioner is the permanent resident of the address mentioned in the cause title. She has come from a respectable family. Now the police are searching her for arrest. In order to safe-guard her interest, prestige and honour she has filed this petition. She is ready to co-operate for investigation. She is ready to abide by the conditions that may be imposed by this court. Accused No.1 is arrested and she is already released on bail. Hence prayed to allow the petition.

5. Prosecution contested this petition by filing detailed objection by reiterating the case of the complainant and further contended that, there is a prima facie case against this accused. If bail is granted, this accused may tamper the prosecution witnesses or she may hamper the investigation. She may abscond. Hence prayed to reject the petition.

6. Heard arguments and perused the records.

7. Now the point for determination is as follows:

1) Whether the petitioner/accused No.2 has made out sufficient grounds to grant an order of anticipatory bail by resorting to

special powers vested in this Court U/S.482 of BNSS?

8. On the basis of the materials available on record, finding to the above point is in the Affirmative for the following:

REASONS

9. **Point No.1:-** I have gone through the entire materials available on record. Even though the alleged offences are non-bailable, they are not punishable with death or imprisonment for life. It is not in dispute that accused No.1 is already released on bail. It is not in dispute that this petitioner is the permanent resident of the address mentioned in the cause title. There is no criminal antecedents. She is ready to cooperate for investigation. She is ready to abide by the conditions that may be imposed by this court. Main allegation is on accused No.1. Under such circumstances reasonable conditions will meet the objection of the prosecution. Hence aforesaid point is answered in the affirmative and proceed to pass the following :

ORDER

Bail petition filed by the petitioner/accused No.2 U/S.482 of BNSS is hereby allowed.

In the event of arrest of this petitioner in Crime No.34/2026 of the respondent police station for the offences punishable U/S.121(1), 132, 352 R/W.3(5) of BNS 2023, she shall be enlarged on bail on her executing personal bond

for a sum of Rs.30,000/- with one surety for like sum on the following conditions:

- 1) Petitioner/accused No.2 shall appear before the Investigating Officer within 10 days from the date of this order.
- 2) She shall co-operate for investigation.
- 3) She shall not tamper the prosecution witnesses.
- 4) She shall appear before the I.O. or the court as and when directed to do so.
