**ORDER**

1. The petitioners/accused No.1 to 10 have filed this petition U/s.482 of BNSS 2023 seeking for an order of anticipatory bail.

2. On the basis of the complaint filed by Smt.Netravati W/o Nagaraja, a case is registered at Mayakonda police station Davanagere in Crime No.30/2025 against the accused for the offences punishable U/S.115(2), 126(2), 189(2), 190, 191(2), 351, 352, 74 of BNS 2023. After investigation the investigating officer has submitted charge sheet against the accused for the aforesaid offences. In addition to that charge sheet is also filed for the offence punishable U/S.118(1) of BNS.

3. The case of the prosecution in brief is that, C.W.5 Karibasamma is having her land in Re-Sy.No.9/4 of Vittalapura village within the jurisdiction of Mayakonda police station. Relating to this land there is a dispute between the

complainant and accused. Since the accused are giving trouble to C.W.5 she had filed complaint in the police station on 15/01/2025. Subsequently on 16/01/2025 at about 5-30 p.m. when C.W.1, 4 to 13 were going towards their village near Shri Udusalamma temple of Vittalapura village this accused wrongfully restrained them and abused them in a filthy language and assaulted them by their hands and legs and gave threat to their life. Accused No.2 and 4 dragged the tuft of the complainant and also dragged her sarry. Accused No.1 had bite on the left hand of the complainant. When C.W.3 to 6, 8 to 10 went to pacify the quarrel this accused assaulted them also. Hence the complainant filed the aforesaid complaint.

4. Now this petitioners/accused No.1 to 10 are contending that, they are innocent persons and they have not committed any offence. False case is registered against them. They have come from a respectable family. They are deep rooted in the society. They are the bread earners of their family. They will not abscond. Investigation is already completed. They will cooperate for trial. Hence prayed to allow the petition.

5. Prosecution contested this petition by filing detailed objection by reiterating the case of the complainant and further contended that, there is a prima facie case against this accused. If bail is granted, this accused may tamper the

prosecution witnesses or they may hamper the investigation. They may abscond. Hence prayed to reject the petition.

6. Heard arguments and perused the records.
7. Now the point for determination is as follows:

- 1) Whether the petitioners/accused No.1 to 10 have made out sufficient grounds to grant an order of anticipatory bail by resorting to special powers vested in this Court U/S.482 of BNSS?

8. On the basis of the materials available on record, finding to the above point is in the Affirmative for the following:

#### **REASONS**

9. **Point No.1:-** I have gone through the entire materials available on record. Even though the alleged offences are non-bailable, they are not punishable with death or imprisonment for life. Investigation is already completed and charge sheet is also submitted. There is a civil dispute between the parties. This petitioners are ready to co-operate for trial. They are ready to abide by the conditions that may be imposed by this court. Already there is a counter case. Under such circumstances reasonable conditions will meet the objection of the prosecution. Hence aforesaid point is answered in the affirmative and proceed to pass the following :

**ORDER**

Bail petition filed by the petitioners/accused No.1 to 10 U/S.482 of BNSS is hereby allowed.

In the event of arrest of this petitioners in Crime No.30/2025 of the respondent police station for the offences punishable U/S.115(2), 118(1), 126(2), 189(2), 190, 191(2), 351(2), 352, 74 of BNS 2023, they shall be enlarged on bail on their executing personal bond for a sum of Rs.30,000/- each with one surety for like sum on the following conditions:

- 1) Petitioners/accused No.1 to 10 shall appear before the trial court within 15 days from the date of this order and shall execute personal bond and shall furnish sureties as aforesaid.
- 2) They shall not tamper the prosecution witnesses.
- 3) They shall appear before the court on all the dates of hearing without fail.
