1. The present application has been filed by the applicant seeking Legal Heirship Certificate under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation Act (VIII) of 1827.
2. According to the applicant, Parvatibai Yadavrao Rajapure died on 28.09.2023. She was permanent resident of Parbhani. Applicant is son of the deceased. There are no heirs of the deceased other than the applicant. Therefore, the applicant has moved this application to obtain a legal heir certificate in his favour.
3. As far as the claim of the applicant is concerned, applicant Dashrath examined himself at Exh.No.11 and reiterated the contents of the application. The applicant filed on record verified copy of death certificate of deceased at Exh. Nos.12, verified copies of Aadhaar Card of applicant at Exh.Nos.13, and public notice at Exh.14.
4. Heard Ld. Advocate for the applicant. He submitted according to the contents of the application. Perused the record before the Court.

5. Having regards to entire facts and circumstances, it appears that, permanent residence and death place of deceased was at Parbhani, within the jurisdiction of this Court. There was due public notice and citation of this application. However, no one objected this application till the date. The applicant is appearing to be the Class-I legal heir of the deceased. There is no impediment to allow this application. Hence, I pass the following order :-

ORDER

- i) The application stands allowed.
 - ii) Issue legal heirship certificate of the deceased namely **Parvatibai Yadavrao Rajapure** in favour of applicant, on depositing the proper Court Fees.
 - iii) The applicant to bear his own costs.
 - iv) The proceedings be closed accordingly.
