In view of the Office Order No. 713/22984-23015/Bail Power/Gaz./PDJ/West/2026, Dated, Delhi the 08.05.2026 of Ld. Principal District & Sessions Judge, West District, Tis Hazari Courts Complex, New Delhi, bail roaster has been assigned to the undersigned.

This is a bail application u/s 483 BNSS moved on behalf of the applicant-accused Jatin for grant of regular bail.

Arguments heard. Record perused.

1. It is argued by the Ld. Counsel appearing on behalf of the accused/applicant that the accused/applicant is in JC since 14.05.2026. It is stated that the accused/applicant has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that applicant/accused has clean past antecedents. It is further submitted that the investigation in this case is already completed and the associates of the applicant/accused has already been granted regular bail. It is further submitted that the applicant/accused is ready to abide by the terms and conditions imposed by the Hon'ble Court. Thus, on the aforesaid grounds accused/applicant be admitted to bail.

2. On the other hand, IO has filed the reply opposing the bail application of the applicant/accused on the ground that the applicant/accused has committed heinous crime. It is further submitted that the robbed bike was recovered at the instance of the present applicant/accused and same was taken into police possession. It is further submitted by the Ld. Additional PP for the state that there is apprehension that applicant/accused may threaten and influence the witness / complainant so he should not be released on bail at this stage. Thus, on the aforesaid grounds the application is sought to be dismissed.

3. I have gone through the submissions and the record.

4. It is pertinent to note that the applicant/accused has been in custody for more than 1.5 months. It is not disputed by the IO that the associates of the applicant/accused who are CCL have already been released on bail. It is further submitted by the IO that no further investigation is left to be conducted in this case and the charge sheet is likely to be filed shortly. As far as apprehension of the prosecution that the applicant/accused may threaten the victim/witness, the same can be taken care of by imposing stringent conditions. Admittedly, the applicant/accused has no previous involvement in any other criminal case. No purpose would be served by keeping the accused/applicant behind the bars for indefinite period merely on the unfounded apprehension of the IO.

5. Considering the submissions, facts and circumstances of this case, this court deems it fit to allow the application of the applicant/accused. Accordingly, applicant/accused **Jatin** is

admitted to regular bail on furnishing of personal bond cum surety bond in sum of **Rs. 10,000/-** with one surety in the like amount subject to following conditions:

- (i) the applicant-accused shall not influence, coerce, pressurize or contact PWs in any manner directly or indirectly;
- (ii) he shall not tamper with the evidence;
- (iii) in case of change of residence, he shall inform the IO as well as the Trial Court immediately;
- (iv) he shall register his mobile phone number with the IO;
- (v) he shall not commit any offence during the bail period;
- (vi) he shall remain present in person or through his Counsel in the present case on every date of hearing fixed and/or as and when so directed by the Court;

6. The present regular bail application of the applicant-accused **Jatin** stands disposed of, accordingly.

7. Bail bonds be furnished before the Ld. Judicial Magistrate First Class concerned/Duty Magistrate/Link Magistrate to its satisfaction.

8. Copy of this Order be given to the Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused, IO, Ld. Trial Court and Jail Superintendent concerned.
