

Case called out before Lok-Adalath.

Perused the compromise-petition filed U/O. 23 Rule 3 R/w 151 of CPC.

The present suit is for partition and separate possession of suit schedule property. Now both the parties intend to compromise the matter as per the terms and conditions mentioned in the compromise petition.

The terms and conditions read over to the parties and on enquiry all parties to the suit admitted the terms and conditions of compromise petition. On perusal of compromise petition, it appears that, compromise is lawful in nature and both the parties agreed for the partition of the property as per the terms and conditions of the compromise petition. Hence, this compromise petition filed U/O 23 Rule 3 R/w 151 of CPC is accepted.

Further office is hereby directed to issue award of Lok-adalath as per compromise petition. Compromise petition is the part and parcel of the Lok-adalath award.

Accordingly matter is disposed before Lok-adalath.
