

ORDERS ON IA NO.1

IA No.1 is filed by the petitioner U/O. 6 Rule 17 R/w Sec. 151 of CPC seeking an order to amend the cause title of the petition as mentioned in the schedule of the petition. Petitioner has sought for deleting respondent No.3 Company and inserted in its place The Manager, The Oriental Company Ltd., branch office: Door No.289/6. A.M. Arcade, Near Vidyarthi Bhavana, C.G. hospital road, Davanagere.

This application is supported by affidavit of petitioner, in the affidavit petitioner has stated she has sustained injuries in the RTA. The Insurance company of the offending vehicle the Oriental insurance company Ltd. But, in the cause title the name of insurance company is mentioned as National insurance company Ltd, the mistake is taken place due to oversight.
