

**ORDERS ON MEDIATION AGREEMENT**

The plaintiff has filed the suit seeking dissolution of marriage, payment of permanent alimony and return of valuable gifts and such other reliefs. The defendant has appeared through his advocate. Thereafter the case was referred to Mediation. Before the mediation the parties have settled their disputes and the

mediation agreement has been entered into them.

After receiving the mediation report with the agreement the plaintiff and the defendant were secured before the court. Both the parties and their respective counsel have filed a compromise petition. The terms of the mediation agreement were read over to the parties. They have admitted the said contents.

Further on 06.03.2026 the plaintiff has acknowledged having received amount of Rs.6,31,000/- through D.D No.011640 dated: 27.02.2026 before the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka from the defendant towards full and final settlement of all claims in this matter and in the criminal petition. Further both the parties have submitted that they have also exchanged articles and jewells before the mediation. Both the parties have submitted that aforesaid settlement between them is full and final and that neither party shall have any claims against each other as per the agreement and the compromise petition. There appears to be no fraud, force or undue influence in the parties entering into the mediation agreement. Since, both parties have admitted the terms and conditions contained in the mediation agreement and compromise petition with free consent and put their signatures to the order sheet the same

has to be accepted. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:

**ORDER**

The mediation agreement entered by the plaintiff and the defendant on 09.03.2026 in this case is accepted.

The suit is disposed off in accordance with the terms and conditions contained in the mediation agreement and the compromise petition.

The marriage of the plaintiff and the defendant which had taken place on 17.11.2022 stands dissolved by this decree.

The mediation agreement dated 09.03.2026 and the compromise petition shall form part and parcel of the decree.

Draw decree accordingly.
