**-: ORDER ON MAIN PETITION :-**

The petitioner filed this petition seeking issuance of directions to respondents to enter the date of death of **Sri. Kariyappa S/o Rangappa (ಶ್ರೀ ಕರಿಯಪ್ಪ ಬಿನ್ ರಂಗಪ್ಪ )**

**who died on 04-06-1963 at Donihalli Village, Channagiri Taluk.** The petition notice to the respondents was duly served. In spite of service of notice, the respondents did not appear. Consequent to the same also. The petitioner has been examined as PW-1 and got marked 3 documents. The Ex-P1 is the copy of non-availability certificate, Ex-P2 is the notarized copy of family tree, Ex-P3 is the notarized copy of aadhaar card of petitioner. The PW-1 has reiterated the contents of the petition in his examination in chief. As the respondents did not choose to appear, the evidence of PW.1 remained unchallenged. There is nothing available on record to disbelieve the version stated by the PW.1 on oath. Apart from this, the explanation given by the PW.1 for non informing the date of death to the concerned authorities is also satisfactory one. The PW.1 is the competent person to say regarding the death. The amendment brought to the registration of Birth and Death Act has been stayed by the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka in W.P.No.24069/2023 clubbed with 20106/2023, W.P.NO.24082/2023 and in that regard the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka was pleased to issue circular number R.J.234/2023 dated 20.12.2023. Thus, this court has got jurisdiction to try the petition and decide it on merits. Hence, in my opinion the petitioner

has made out grounds to issue directions to the respondents authority as prayed in the petition. Hence, I pass the following,

**:- ORDER :-**

The petition filed by the petitioner is hereby allowed.

The respondents are hereby directed to register the date of death of **Sri. Kariyappa S/o Rangappa** (ಶ್ರೀ ಕರಿಯಪ್ಪ ಬಿನ್ ರಂಗಪ್ಪ) **who died on 04-06-1963 at Donihalli Village, Channagiri Taluk** and to issue death certificate to the petitioner by collecting necessary fees.
