The petitioner and his counsel are present. Respondent is also present. The parties are intending to settled the matter before Lok-Adalath. Accordingly, the matter is conciliate.

Both the parties have filed joint memo stating that the respondent has consented to enter the date of birth of the petitioner in the Birth and Death register and issue birth certificate subject to condition that, if any dispute regarding Birth, it is not conclusive proof.

The petitioner and his counsel as well as respondent signed the joint memo. Perused the joint memo and documents produced by the petitioner. On perusal of the same it reveals that there is no entry of date of birth of petitioner in the Birth and Death register. As per the joint memo the respondent consented to make necessary entry in the concerned register, subject to condition that, if any dispute regarding date of Birth. It is not conclusive proof. Therefore, I proceed to pass the following.

**:- ORDER :-**

The petition filed by the petitioner is hereby allowed.

The respondents are hereby directed to register the date of birth of petitioner by name **B. NIJALINGAPPA S/O BASAPPA** (ಬಿ. ನಿಜಲಿಂಗಪ್ಪ ಬಿನ್ ಬಸಪ್ಪ) who born on **25-05-1964** at **Honnebagi village, Channagiri Taluk**, in the concerned register and issue birth certificate in favour of the petitioner, subject to condition that if any dispute arise regarding date of birth, it is no conclusive proof.
